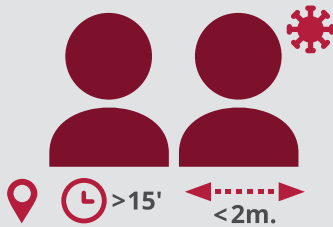


NOTIFYING A POTENTIAL COVID-19 CONTACT/EXPOSURE



Close contact

Notify close contact with a confirmed covid-19 case if you not wearing a face mask, and the contact happened for more than 15 minutes and at a distance of under two meters.



Compatible symptoms

Notify close contact also if in contact with someone showing compatible symptoms (high fever or chills, loss of sense of smell or taste, cough, shortness of breath or breathing difficulty, sore throat, muscle or body aches, headache, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting, general lack of strength) regardless of whether the person has tested positive or negative, or has not been tested at all.



Confirmed case

Notify confirmed case if you have tested positive in a PCR or antigen test or if your doctor confirms the infection.



Notify the Designated School Covid19 Staff Member

In each Faculty, School or Centre there will be a staff member designated to deal with all issues related to Covid-19. Notify your close contact or confirmed case to this person.



Notify the UCLM Covid Medical Team (covid@uclm.es)

The UCLM offers medical advice and help via its UCLM Covid Medical Team, whose tasks include:

- Observation of confirmed cases at the UCLM
- Medical and health advice
- Certification of isolation period recommendation and completion

How to act if a potentially positive case is identified and/or confirmed

Access to the university facilities will be banned for:

- students and staff with compatible symptoms (potential exposure)
- students and staff who have tested positive (confirmed cases)
- students and staff in preventive isolation due to close contact

How to act if symptoms are identified inside the UCLM facilities:

- Identification (name and contact details of probable case)
- The student or staff member with compatible symptoms will immediately return home and notify his/her doctor
- If journey home is not possible: student or staff member will remain in an isolation room

Notification of potential cases:

Students or staff who have had a potential exposure will send the following information:

- Full Name
- ID or Passport Number
- Email address and telephone number
- Status within the UCLM (student or staff)
- Faculty or School and Campus
- Degree and year
- Date of notification



to the Faculty, School or Center covid-19 designated staff member as well as to the following email address: covid@uclm.es, where further instructions will be received.

* N.B. Failure to comply with the mandatory isolation period, and failure to notify a medical condition (positive test) will be considered a felony punishable with up to 60,000€ in fines.
