Founded in 1985, our University now offers 47 bachelor's degree programmes and 35 official master's degrees programmes, all of which are in accordance with the standards of the European Higher Education Area (EHEA). Moreover, the UCLM proffers a wide selection of post-graduate courses and 18 PhD programmes.

Our institution, founded 25 years ago, has consolidated itself as a top university within the Spanish Tertiary Education System.
