Founded in 1985, our University now offers 47 bachelor's degree programmes and 35 official master's degrees programmes, all of which are in accordance with the standards of the European Higher Education Area (EHEA). Moreover, the UCLM proffers a wide selection of post-graduate courses and 18 PhD programmes.

Our institution, founded 25 years ago, has consolidated itself as a top university within the Spanish Tertiary Education System. Internationally, the UCLM holds cooperation agreements and relations with approximately 715 world- wide academic centers and institutions. This constitutes the perfect frame to let our students and professors go abroad and permit international students and professors to come to UCLM. According to the 2015-2016 statistics, around 700 worldwide students arrived at the UCLM to start or continue their education. As an international institution that receives worldwide students and has international accords with more than 700 international institutions and organizations, the University of Castilla-La Mancha is clearly committed with its internationalization.
