GUIDELINES FOR NGOE AUTHORS

- NGOE publishes original scientific and review scientific papers written in English language.
- Please follow instructions for authors at the journal's web page.
- The abstract should be structured in the following 4-6 parts (all in one paragraph): purpose, methodology/approach, findings, research limitations (if applicable), implications (if applicable) and originality/value.
- Include up to three JEL codes. JEL classification can be found here.
- The paper should follow a typical structure of an original scientific paper including a comprehensive literature review. A well-presented IMRAD structure can be found here.
- In Introduction section describe background, main goal, a brief literature review, the structure of the rest of the paper.
- Include a comprehensive literature review citing numerous up to date scientific papers published in high ranked scientific journals.
- In Methodology section explain in detail the methodology applied in the paper, including clearly stated hypothesis or research question, and present the sources and characteristics of the data.
- In Conclusion section present main conclusions, include the answer to the research question/accept or reject the hypothesis with arguments derived from the original research presented in the paper, emphasize originality/value, limitations and further research possibilities.
- References should be cited according to the APA style.
