

FLIGHT OPERATIONS EXPERT - UAS PILOT

Job requirements:

- University degree in a technical field (preferably engineering).
- PPL licence.
- A1/A3 and STS-02 (or STS-ES-02) remote UAS pilot certifications.
- Minimum of five years' experience in operations management and team leadership.
- Minimum of two years' experience in manned aircraft operation, with a minimum of 150 hours as PIC.
- B2 level of English or equivalent.
- Proficiency in Microsoft 365 (Word, Excel, Access).
- Use of flight manuals and online operations.
- Management of flight planning applications

Merits to be assessed:

- CPL / ATPL Licence.
- Training in:
 - UAS pilot requirements under operational authorisations.
 - Aircraft type courses, type ratings.
- Experience in:
 - Recent experience in operating manned and/or unmanned aircraft, particularly the model to be operated.
 - Work in organisations involved in manned aircraft operations: AOC, SPO, ATO; or unmanned aircraft operations: LUC, UAS Operator, Training Entities.
 - UAS flights (multirotor and/or helicopters).
 - Model Aircraft (RC).
 - Management of coordination requests and operations with ANSP

Duties:

Management of both the facility itself and the operations carried out there. Planning and coordination of operational personnel. Planning and operation of unmanned aircraft (CAMCOPTER S-100 helicopter and multicopter). Coordination with airport service and/or air navigation managers. Collaboration in the development of risk analysis for operations that may be carried out. Acting as a payload operator according to schedule. Analysis and issuance of reports on data extracted from payloads. Management of flight documentation at the base of operations (records, flight manuals, operations manual, recurrent training, etc.). Application of EASA/AESA standards in UAS operations.

Working hours: Flexible. The service will be provided at the Gran Canaria operational base of El Berriel.
